



WEEKLY UPDATE ON ASEAN PLUS THREE RICE SITUATIONS

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Cambodia

Cambodia exported 412,023 tonnes of milled rice in the first eight months of 2024.

According to the Cambodia Rice Federation, Cambodia exported 412,023 tonnes of milled rice from January to August 2024, worth 305 million USD. The country shipped to 65 countries and China was one of the top rice importers by exporting 77,792 tonnes of milled rice to China, making a gross revenue of almost 48.9 million USD.

Myanmar

Myanmar gains 353 million USD from the first five months of 2024-25 fiscal year.

According to the Myanmar Rice Federation, Myanmar exported 718,281 tonnes of rice and broken rice from April to August, earning 353 million USD. The 207,369 tonnes of rice and broken rice were exported in August 2024, generating 97 million USD in revenue.

Thailand

Rates for Thai rice were up for a second straight week to the highest since late June 2024.

Prices for Thailand's 5 percent broken rice slightly increased to 585 USD per tonne from 580 USD per tonne last week. As the baht strengthened against the dollar, rice prices rose to the highest level in over 2 months, a Bangkok-based trader said.

Viet Nam

Vietnamese rice prices dropped amid tepid trading activities.

According to the Vietnam Food Association, Vietnamese 5 percent broken rice prices were quoted at 575 USD per tonne from 578 USD per tonne a week earlier. Prices are quite stable while traders are still waiting for bidding results from Bulog, a Mekong Delta-based trader said. Moreover, trading activities remained slow after the holiday.
